

CRUISE HA LONG & BAI TU LONG 3 DAYS - LUXURY AND OFF-THE-BEATEN TRACK CRUISE

Routes: Hanoi - Ha Long – Hanoi

Duration: 3 Days / 2 Nights

Features: A great way to see spectacular Ha Long Bay is a slow cruise through the seemingly never-ending bay of islands. Lay in the sun, enjoy a selection of the freshest seafood, and capture photograph after photograph.

On **Dragon Pearl** traditional junk, we aim to get off the beaten track but still at a leisurely pace. The size of the new vessel will allow the passengers to get much closer to Ha Long Bay's natural wonders, pocket lagoons, and its small fishing communities.



Day 1: Hanoi to Ha Long, welcome on board



Departure for Ha Long Bay is around 8:00 AM in a shared van (about 4 hour drive) from your hotel.


At 10:30, pause for the water puppet show performed by local artists at a traditional Vietnamese village then have lunch.

After that we go ahead for Ha Long Bay and arrive at the port around 1:30 PM. Welcomed on

board, you are taken to your cabin before the trip briefing. Fresh, local seafood lunch while you cruise to Bai Tu Long Bay and admire the fascinating formations. Enjoy our padding around Cap La fishing village by kayak then we keep cruising to Cong Do and back to junk for swimming or enjoy relaxing or the sunset. Dinner and overnight on board.

Day 2: Explore Cong Dam & dinner in Thien Canh Son cave



Early risers can enjoy the sunrise and the quiet breath-taking beauty of Bay's landscape.

At 7:30 AM, you have breakfast in the fresh air on board then take morning cruise to Cong Dam while discovering geological values of Bai Tu Long Bay with the thousands of islands and islets. Our lunch will be served on boat before cruising to Hon Co island for swimming or kayaking to

discover the stunning scenery of the Bay. Back to our junk. Take rest on your own cabin or enjoy your relaxing time.

Explore the well – hidden and enjoy our deluxe dinner in Thien Canh Son cave. Stay overnight on board.

Day 3: Explore the tranquil scenery in Bai Tu Long Bay, back to Hanoi



Take more chance to enjoy fresh air, gentle breeze of Bai Tu Long bay – a hidden charm in the early morning. Have breakfast on board at 7:30 AM then take a morning cruise around the magnificent scenery to a short rustic row boat by the locals of the Bay. Back the cruise for checkout from the cabin. Lunch on the boat as we slowly cruise back to port.

We will be ashore around 12:30 PM then hit the road back to Hanoi. Arrive in your hotel at around 5:30 PM. Tour ends at your hotel.
